

# What is No Nukes Asia Actions (NNAA) about?

**They are a group of citizens striving to find a way to a nuke-free world, hand-in-hand with like-minded people of the world.**

## Our launch

It first began in the summer of 2012 and later resulted in the successful launch of NNAA on November 10<sup>th</sup> of the same year, at a press conference held at *Shinano-machi Church*.

The event was covered by some newspapers and internet news sites. Moreover, the kickoff conference consisted of participants from Mongolia, South Korea, Taiwan, and Canada.

## How we, NNAA, view the world

This page shows *only some* of the world's NPP issues are. Nuclear energy always has been, and still is, an issue involving the whole planet, not just any single nation – radioactive-contaminated water from Fukushima I is being dumped into the Pacific Ocean! This has led us to kick off the No Nukes Asia Actions. We are convinced that to build a world free from nukes, citizens of the planet have to work together!



## What we have done so far (as of July 2013)

**Summer, 2012** Held preparatory meetings, set up websites, etc. both in English and Japanese.

**Oct.** NNAA's rep, Mr. Choi Seungkoo, visited Taiwan's environmental and anti-nuke groups for cooperation talks.

**Nov.** Official launch of NNAA, at the press conference at *Shinano-machi Church*

**Dec.** Sent a letter of protest to the IAEA, which held its meeting in Fukushima.

**Feb., 2013** Held a lecture by Mr. Ichiyo Muto (In Kawasaki, Kanagawa)

**Mar.** Held lectures by Rev. Lee from South Korea and Ms. Atsuko Ogasawara from "Asako House" (an anti-nuke house inside Ohma NPP's premises)

**Now, we are preparing to file the "Reactor Suppliers Lawsuit" described on the other side!**

## Things we are planning to do

- Organize events and campaigns promoting the litigation.
- Organize a series of small-scale seminars.
- Continue working closely with anti-nuke organizations in Taiwan to abolish its "NPP No. 4", while doing the same with friends in South Korea.
- Protest against nuclear imports and exports
- Protest against plans to build nuke disposal areas in Mongolia... and others, all in collaboration with anti-nukes worldwide!

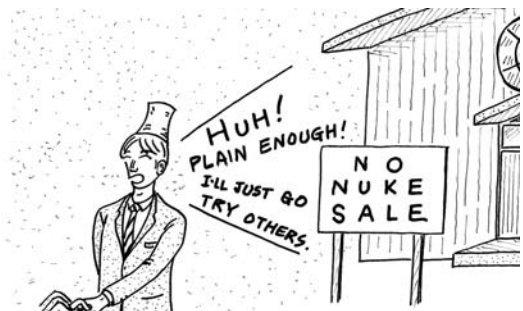
## Nuke power = "Monster biz"

For more than 28 months, Fukushima I's meltdown has been going on and it is still generating heat today. Indeed, NPPs are likened to a "fire-throwing monster"!

What has allowed such deadly monsters trample Mother Earth? One major factor is the legal provisions in many countries (except India); reactor suppliers are not liable for accidents caused by its products!

## Laws protecting the monsters!

Having such laws in place, reactor suppliers will keep contaminating the earth and exposing people to danger through their "monster business"! Even after the ongoing disaster of Fukushima I, they still sell their "products of death" to India, Turkey, etc.



## As for Japan ---

Referring to Japan's Act of Compensation for Nuclear Damages (enacted in 1961), according to our translation: "This Act is **intended to contribute to sound development of the nuclear industry**" Hence, the legal system itself is advocating nuclear energy.

## Therefore, NNAA is now preparing:

- The "Reactor Suppliers Lawsuit", as of August 2013.
- This lawsuit involves questioning justifiability of the Act, which exempts reactor suppliers from assuming legal responsibilities accorded with a NPP accident.

Our intentions are:

- to incite talks on reactor businesses' amenability worldwide.
- to invite reactor suppliers to "turn green."
- to terminate NPP exports and imports, in close cooperation with people of the world.

In short, we want a "world free of nukes"!
